



**VII INTERNATIONAL CHESS FESTIVAL  
"CHOJNICE - OPEN 2011"  
Chojnice 8-16.07.2011**

**Student's Sport Club "Ósemka" Chojnice and Activities Room of Grammar School no 1 with associated Municipal Department, Chojnice District, Chojnice Sailing Club, Promotion of Chojnice Region and Aquapark in Chojnice organize in 8 – 16 July 2011 the VII INTERNATIONAL CHESS FESTIVAL.**

The festival's main aim is popularization of the King's Game., raising chess skills and qualifications of the players, integration of the chess players through sport competition according to FIDE maxim „GENS UNA SUMUS” (WE ARE ALL THE FAMILY) and promotion of Chojnice and it's touring and sporting values.

The competition will take place in **Grammar School no 1, Młodzieżowa Street 44 in Chojnice**. The playing hall contains: big gym (playing place), canteen, washing facilities with connected hallways.

The tournament will be played in 4 groups in Swiss system at distance of 9 rounds. The rate of play in Open A will be 90 minutes with 30 seconds cumulative increment for each move starting from first move. In the other groups will be 23 moves in 1 hour followed by 1 hour for the rest of the game. The final standing is determined by the number of points scored. One point for win, half point for a draw and no points for lose. If number of points will be equal then decide: small Buchholz, big Buchholz, number of wins and progress.

- **OPEN A** – for players with rating at least 2000 (entrance fee 75 PLN),
- **OPEN B** – for players with rating 1601- 2000 (entrance fee 60 PLN),
- **OPEN C** – for players with rating until 1600 (entrance fee 50 PLN),
- **OPEN D** – for juniors to 16 years old (entrance fee 35 PLN),

People over 60 years old and players of UKS "Ósemka" pay half of the entrance fee. Grand Masters and International Masters don't pay the entrance fee.

**Classification-rating fee isn't included in the entrance fee.**

Tournaments with Fide players (OPEN A i B) are announced to FIDE. Open D will be submitted to classification for central categories.

**1. Prizes: The win in Group A - 2.000 PLN, in Group B - 800 PLN, in Group C - 400 PLN, in Open D - material prizes.** The number and amount of other prizes will be declared after the 3rd round. In OPEN A, B, C there will be money prizes for the best women and in OPEN D there will be material prizes for the best girls. In OPEN D there will be separate boys classification to <8, <10 <12 <14 and <16 years old and for girls to <12 and <16. Split of awards is regulated by Award Regulation.

Cost of accommodation of visitors in District Pupils' Hostel – 20 PLN + VAT (7%), the board 30 PLN, or the dinner separately 15PLN per person.

Accommodation in “OLIMP” hotel:

45 – 90 PLN per a single room

60 – 120 PLN per a double room

69 – 140 PLN per a 3 person room

80 – 165 PLN per a 4 person room

Full board in “Słoneczna” restaurant near OLIMP hotel costs 28 – 30 PLN (dinner 15PLN).

There is possibility of accommodation in “Turystyczny” hotel (in the city center) – costs similar to “OLIMP” hotel.

The organizer isn't instrumental in the achievement of places in hotels. The number of places in the District Pupils' Hostel is limited and the sequence of registrations is decisive.

The prizes of accommodation and food are subject to change in circumstances irrespective of the organizer.

Arrivals of competitors will be on the 8<sup>th</sup> of July 2011, technical meeting (verification of starting lists and confirmation of participation) the same day at 18.00 in the game hall.
